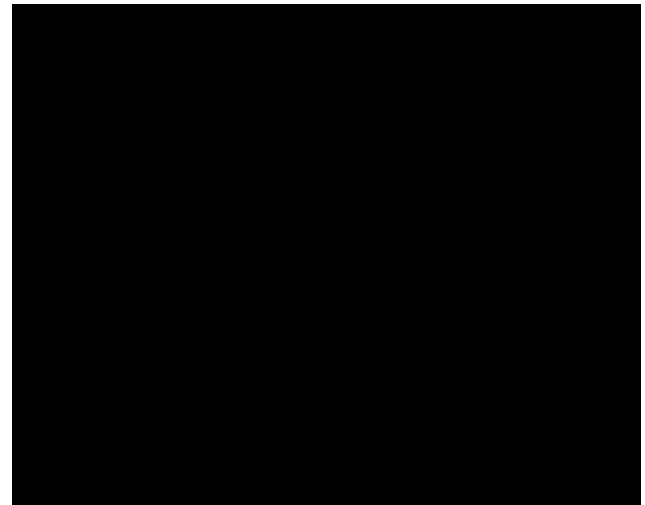

Graduation Ceremony

- Arrive to Bojangles on Monday, June 10th by **6:00pm** dressed in full regalia (cap, gown & tassel)
 - Be careful not to lose your tassel
 - Don't forget to wear any cords you earned



Dress Code

- Please wear business/semi-formal dark attire underneath your cap and gown.
- Students should **not** decorate their regalia.
- You will not walk if you show up to graduation with a decorated cap and gown.
- You may not wear any stoles or cords that are not CMS approved



Dress Code

Appropriate Attire

- Dress, skirt or pant suits with dress blouses or tops, and dress shoes.
- Dress shirt, suit, dress pants, button down or traditional business shirt, and dress shoes.
- Please wear comfortable shoes/heels for graduation.



Inappropriate Attire

- **NO SNEAKERS, SLIPPERS, SLIDES, FLIP-FLOPS, SUNGLASSES**
- **DO NOT WEAR JEANS OR PAJAMAS**



What NOT to bring to Graduation!

- **Graduates: no keys, phones, gum, sunglasses, pocketbooks or purses!**
 - Leave with family or guests or they will be confiscated by MCHS staff.
 - Confiscated items will be returned to you when you pick up your diploma.
 - We are not responsible for confiscated items.
