Sun Bucks



SUN Bucks is a program intended to provide grocery-buying benefits to children who lose access to Free or Reduced Price (FRP) school meals when school is out during the summer months. It's a one-time \$120 benefit per eligible child provided on a debit-like card that can be used on groceries anywhere that accepts SNAP/EBT benefits. Most children who qualify will be found automatically eligible, and do not need to apply. Students DON'T need to apply if they get FRP meals because they have an approved FRP meals application on file at their school or have food stamps or Medicaid.

The application is based on income, so a child not in one of the above groups can apply to have their income eligibility determined. 

Test Taking Strategies for Parents

- 1. Make sure your child gets a good night sleep the night before the test.
- 2.On the morning of the test, your child needs to get up early and eat a healthy breakfast.
- 3. Reassure your child that no matter the outcome, you will always love him/her
- 4. Give your child plenty of praise even if he/she doesn't do well on the test.
- 5. Plan a fun outing or reward after your child finishes the test.
- 6. Provide practice opportunities for your child to do sample testing questions. Ask your child's teacher if you need some examples. It's important to remember that sometimes children may get anxious about testing, If this happens, tell them to focus on their breathing and have them take deep, cleansing breaths and slowly exhaling.
